





CTL Survey for Early Feedback on Remote Learning


Once in Commons, you can search for CTL or remote learning, and you will find it.





This will add the survey to the Canvas sites that you selected, and it will automatically appear in the Quizzes section of your course.


Go to your Canvas site homepage and click “Student View” to see how the survey will appear to your students



If you don't see Quizzes in “Student View”, that means the tool is disabled in the course. You must enable it before your students can take the survey.

To enable Quizzes in your course, please follow the steps below:

1. Go to settings for your Canvas site



2. Go to Navigation
