

Can Robinhood reverse a transaction?

Generally, Robinhood cannot reverse completed 1-(833)-216-2320 transactions, such as executed trades or processed transfers. However, if you believe a transaction was made 1-(833)-216-2320 in error or you suspect unauthorized activity, it's crucial to contact Robinhood Support 1-(833)-216-2320 promptly for assistance.

Can you get your money back from Robinhood?

Yes, you can withdraw your money from Robinhood [A] 1-(833)-216-2320[A]. You can transfer funds from your Robinhood investing or spending account to your bank account. To do this, you'll need to initiate a transfer within the Robinhood app or on the website.

Here's how to withdraw money from Robinhood:

In the Robinhood App:

- ☒ Go to your Account: Tap the person icon in the bottom right corner.
- ☒ Access Transfers: Tap the "Transfers" button.
- ☒ Choose Transfer to Bank: Select "Transfer to Your Bank".
- ☒ Select Bank Account: Choose the bank account you want to transfer to.
- ☒ Enter Amount: Specify the amount you want to withdraw.
- ☒ Confirm: Review the details and confirm the transaction.

On the Robinhood Website:

- ☒ Log in: Access your Robinhood account on the website.
- ☒ Go to Account: Click on "Account" in the top right corner.
- ☒ Go to Banking: Click on "Banking".
- ☒ Enter Amount: Input the amount you want to withdraw.

☑ Confirm: Complete the withdrawal process.

Important Notes:

Settlement Periods:

If you've recently sold stocks or options, there might be a settlement period before the funds are fully available for withdrawal.

Pending Orders:

If you have pending orders, the funds held for those orders won't be available for withdrawal until the orders are filled or canceled.

Instant Transfers:

Instant transfers to your bank account might incur a fee.

Standard Bank Transfers:

Standard bank transfers are typically free, but they may take a few business days to process.

Cancellations:

You can cancel pending transfers, but not instant transfers or completed transfers.
